“Appropriate Campus Authority”

§ 40105. Definition of “Appropriate Campus Authority”

Whenever the term “appropriate campus authority” is used in this Subchapter [2: Educational Program], it shall be deemed to mean the President of the campus acting upon the recommendation of the faculty of the campus.
