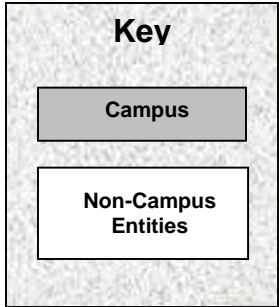
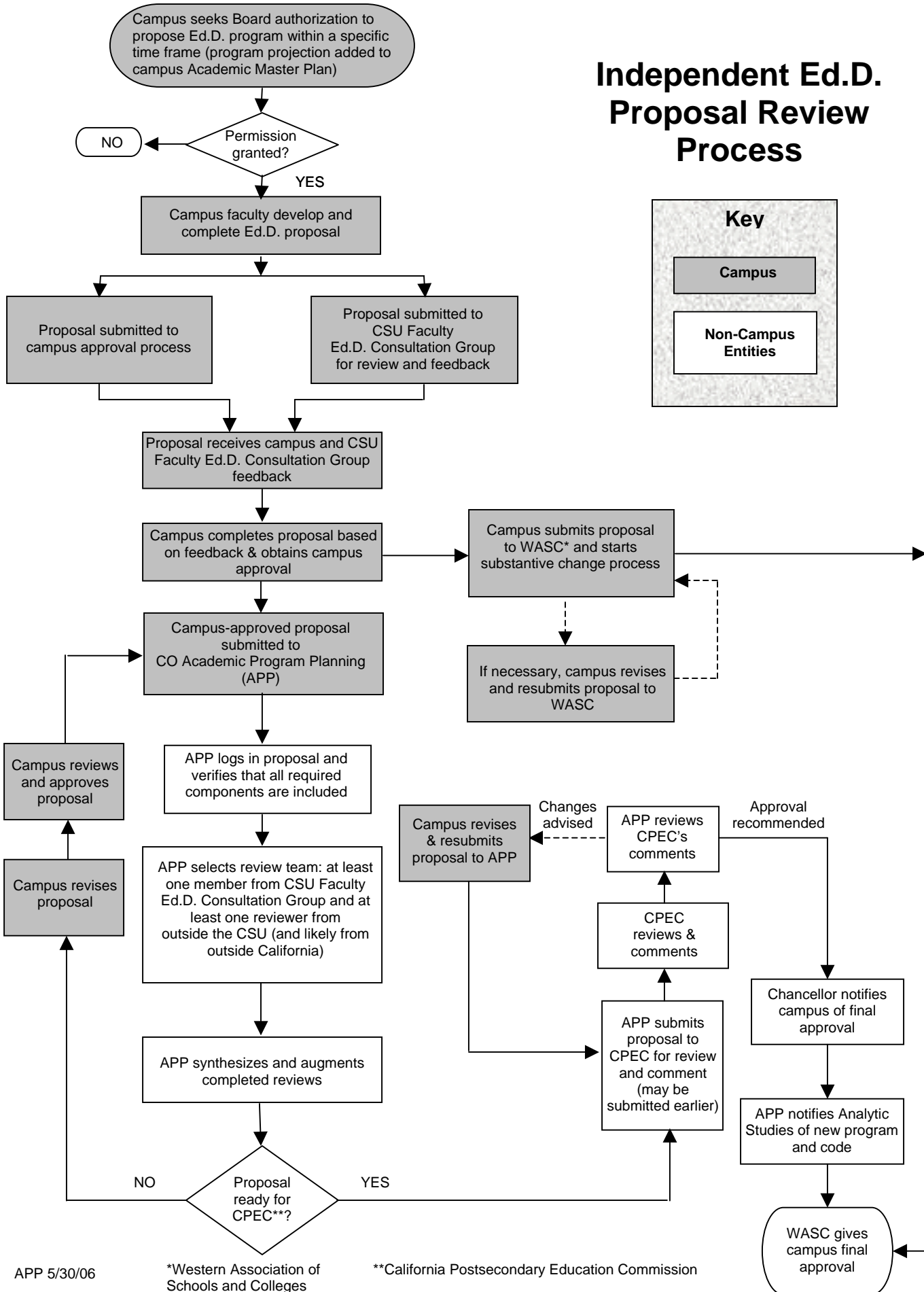


**Sample Implementation Timeline:
CSU Ed.D. Program in Educational Leadership**

This is a recommended timeline for Ed.D. programs beginning in 2007-08. Completing items at the earliest possible dates will be important in order to receive all required approvals.

Independent Ed.D. Proposal Review Process

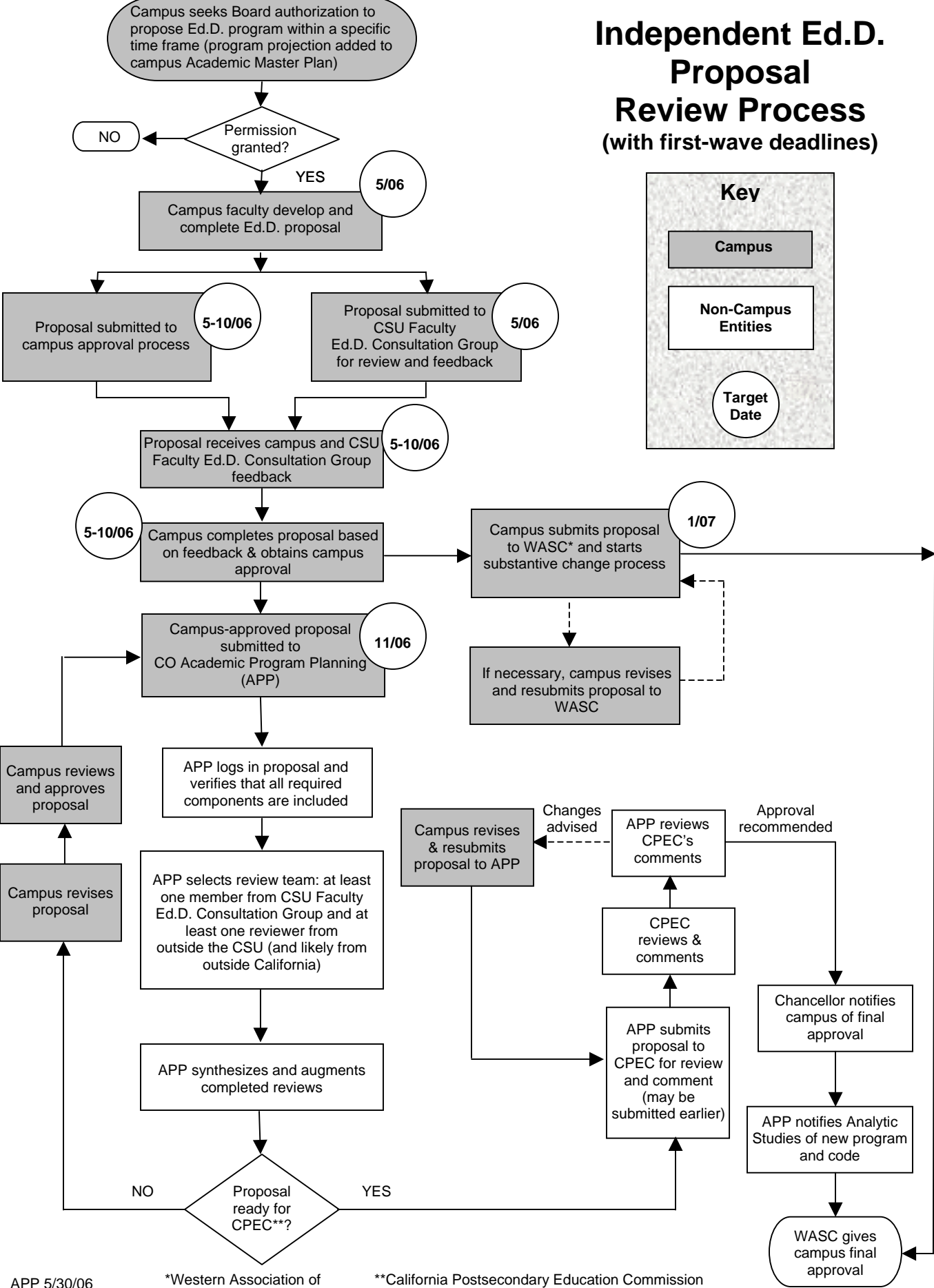

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Issues Likely To Be Important in WASC Review of Ed.D. Programs

(Common Issues from WASC Review of Recent Joint Ed.D. Programs)

- **Planning/Approval and Governance Processes** (WASC Substantive Change Manual, Section 6)
Issue:
 - Processes for governance and for changes in curriculum and for conducting program reviews
 - WASC reviews have focused on the fact that programs requiring collaboration and partnerships have distinct challenges.*
- **Faculty Resources** (WASC Substantive Change Manual, Section 8)
Issues:
 - Additional support for faculty to maintain the new degree level
 - Faculty commitment to research and ability to chair dissertation committees
 - Faculty background and experience to engage in doctoral-level instruction
- **Financial Resources** (WASC Substantive Change Manual, Section 13)
Issues:
 - Start-up costs and how the costs will be covered
 - Minimum number of students necessary to make the program financially viable
 - Three-to-five year budget, including projected income and expenditures, that demonstrates program is fiscally sound
- **Plan for Evaluating Educational Effectiveness** (WASC Substantive Change Manual, Section 14)
Issues:
 - Plan for how the program will be reviewed
 - Procedures for including the assessment plan in a program review and assessment process involving feedback and revision
 - WASC reviews have included particular attention to how the assessment feedback process is to be addressed in a program that involves a number of partners.*
