

Transfer Success Pathway (TSP) Program	CSU Transfer Planner Tool
<p><b>Purpose:</b> a program that provides a dual admission opportunity for eligible first-time, first-year students enrolling in California Community Colleges who commit to transferring to a California State University (CSU) within three years, provided all requirements of the agreement are met.</p> <p><b>Key Features:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dual admission program to the CSU</li> <li>• Guaranteed admission to a CSU and program of the student’s choice, if all requirements are met</li> <li>• Provides an online tool that allows students to explore the CSU system and helps students navigate transfer admission</li> <li>• Receive personalized guidance from CSU campus representatives and access to resources while completing the terms of agreement</li> </ul> <p><b>Access:</b> Information about Transfer Success Pathway, including a link to the portal can be found at <a href="http://www.calstate.edu/transfersuccess">www.calstate.edu/transfersuccess</a>.</p> <p>All 23 CSUs have implemented the Transfer Success Pathway program effective August 2023. Available programs vary by campus.</p> <p>As guided by the Governor’s Council for Post-Secondary Education Recovery with Equity report and the Postsecondary Education Trailer Bill (AB 132), the Transfer Success Pathway program will help improve the student transfer experience while addressing potential equity issues as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, issues with academic preparation and other challenges facing high school students.</p>	<p><b>Purpose:</b> an online tool that assists students attending a CCC and intending to transfer to one of the 23 CSUs with researching programs, learning about transfer admission requirements, tracking their academic progress, and entering into an agreement with a CSU of their choice.</p> <p><b>Current Key Features:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>TSP Eligibility Questionnaire-</b> determines student’s eligibility to participate in an agreement</li> <li>• <b>Enroll in TSP-</b> allows students to select a campus and program to enter into a transfer agreement</li> <li>• <b>General Transfer Requirements-</b> detailed information about transfer requirements</li> <li>• <b>Explore Programs and Universities-</b> detailed admission requirements and general information for programs offered at each of the 23 CSUs, including which programs are available for a transfer agreement</li> <li>• <b>Helpful tips</b> that will prepare students to transfer in a timely manner</li> <li>• <b>Communication-</b> students will receive communications through the portal to guide them through the process and build connection as they complete the terms of agreement</li> </ul> <p><b>What Students Can Expect from this Tool:</b></p> <p><i>Current</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explore 23 CSUs and programs offered</li> <li>• Learn transfer admission general requirements</li> <li>• Learn program-specific requirements</li> <li>• View articulation agreement data through ASSIST</li> </ul>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stay connected to CSU(s) through communication and outreach via the portal</li> <li>• Enter into a transfer agreement with an open campus/program</li> <li>• CCCs designees receive weekly reports of TSP enrolled students</li> </ul> <p><i>Coming January 2024</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Add coursework for each term completed at a CCC</li> <li>• Track progress toward completion of 60-unit requirement and Golden 4</li> <li>• Receive achievement badges for each benchmark completed</li> <li>• Compare current GPA against GPA requirements</li> <li>• Track progress toward transfer to the CSU of their choice</li> <li>• Track programs of interest at various campuses</li> </ul> <p><i>Future Enhancements</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Integration of Transfer Planner with Cal State Apply to create a seamless transition of data and reduce application completion time</li> <li>• Map ADT data so enrollees can track progress toward ADT completion and receive notifications if they are off-track with ADT coursework progress</li> <li>• Full integration with ASSIST for students to track General Education and major prerequisites for specific campuses and programs.</li> </ul> <p><b>Access:</b> Students can access this tool by creating a new user account or logging into an existing account they have already created: <a href="https://csutransfer.myliaison.com/">https://csutransfer.myliaison.com/</a></p> <p>All 23 CSUs have implemented the CSU Transfer Planner effective August 2023.</p>
