CSU General Education

Effective Fall 2025

- CSU policy updates:
 - Subject Area titles and number identifiers -Areas 1 to Area 6
 - Lower-division requirements reduced to 34 semester units or 45 quarter units
 - Area 3 Arts and Humanities reduced to 6 units
 - Removal of Lifelong Learning requirement
 - No systemwide course pattern or CSU GE certification.






CSU General Education

- The subject area numbering aligns with Cal-GETC, but CSU did not adopt all the elements and criteria from the Cal-GETC pattern.
- CSU maintains minimum grade requirement of C- in GE policy for the "Golden Four":
 - Area 1A English Composition, Area 1B Critical Thinking, Area 1C Oral Communication, and Area 2 Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning



Cal-GETC Effective Fall 2025

- Cal-GETC is the singular transfer pathway for California community college (CCC) students to fulfill lower-division GE requirements for the CSU (see Cal-GETC Standards 1.2 for course pattern).
- Partial certification is not available for Cal-GETC.

Transfer and Articulation

- CCC students who transfer without full certification are subject to individual evaluation of coursework at each CSU campus.
- Although not part of GE, CCC students may continue to fulfill CSU Al graduation requirements at the CCC before transfer.
- CSU policies remain the same for External Exams and Credit for Prior Learning.
- The CSU continues to accept baccalaureate level transfer credit from institutionally accredited colleges and universities.



ADT Reminders

- Effective Fall 2025, Cal-GETC will be the singular GE pattern attached to ADT degrees.
- Counselor site: <u>TMC Search Site</u> (TMC similar database)
 Real time data from our TMC Database
- ADT Search Site: <u>ADT and CSU Program Search Site</u> (public search by community college or CSU campus)
 - Updated every few months
 - File informs Cal State Apply data
