Statutory Definition of Hate Incidents

- "Hate crime" means a criminal act committed, in whole or in part, because of one or more of the following actual or perceived characteristics of the victim. California Penal Code Section 422.55.
- "Hate violence" means any act of physical intimidation or physical harassment, physical force or physical violence, or the threat of physical force or physical violence, that is directed against any person or group of persons, or the property of any person or group of persons because of the ethnicity, race, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, disability, or political or religious beliefs of that person or group.

California Education Code Section 67380

Reported hate crimes and violence

According to Statutory Definitions

- Reports <u>include</u> hate crimes under California Penal Code (422.55) and hate violence under the Education Code (section 67380)
- Reports <u>exclude</u> incidents not on university property, protected but inappropriate speech, and harassment that does not include a threat of bodily harm


