- The CSU policy titled California State University Insurance Requirements (PolicyStat ID 16708473) has been updated by Systemwide Risk Management as it relates to comprehensive or commercial form general liability including, but not limited to, Service Agreements for both Public Works and Non-Public Works. Coverage values for each occurrence is now \$2,000,000 with a general aggregate of \$4,000,000.

Applicability: All new Public Works, and Non-Public Works, Service Agreements that were not already under solicitation for scope of services as of October 7, 2024. Service Agreements based upon existing Master Enabling Agreements (MEA) are not affected until renewal of the MEA. For small projects, or agreements with low risk, where vendors may be unable to meet these requirements, campuses are advised to engage with CPDC Planning and Design, and their Risk Management team to determine if lower levels are acceptable. Documentation of reasons for waiving the requirements shall be included in the project file, and supplemental general conditions shall be included in the agreement.
