Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN)	The IRS prefers you provide your Social Security Number (SSN). But if you have a personal Employer Identification Number (EIN) you can use that, but you cannot use an EIN attached to a Single-Member LLC.	Tax Identification Number field (in the Company Overview section) must match SSN or personal EIN on W-9.
W-9 boxes 5-6	Must provide your physical location/street address (no PO Box)	The <b>"physical" address</b> provided (in the Addresses section) must be your physical location/street address and should match boxes 5-6 of your W-9.
