**Request for Additional Faculty Membership on the Chancellor's Office CSU
Generative AI Committee**

1. RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of the California State University (ASCSU) request that the CSU Office of the Chancellor add additional faculty members from different disciplines to the CSU Generative AI Committee subcommittee on teaching and learning; and be it

2. RESOLVED: That the ASCSU distribute this resolution to:

CSU Chancellor
CSU campus Presidents
CSU campus Senate Chairs

Rationale

Currently the CSU Generative AI Committee has only two members from the faculty, one of whom is serving on the Efficiency subcommittee, leaving only one member of the faculty serving on the subcommittee on Teaching and Learning. Since AI will affect pedagogy differently depending on the discipline, the ASCSU requests that the faculty representation on the subcommittee on teaching and learning be expanded to include both a larger number and faculty from a variety of different disciplines.
