



Objective




Provide students the opportunity to design a customized major to meet their educational goals

- Support the success of students with a high number of units without a clear pathway to graduation
- Offer a pathway for students seeking a flexible and/or unique degree

Program Structure

- Interdisciplinary Core (9 units)
 Individualized Degree Plan (36 units)
 Optional
- Internship/s (1-6 units) *Credit for Prior Learning (1-15 units)*



Building for Equity



Access

- Meet students where they are
- Complete degree in-person, online, or hybrid

Flexibility

- Integrate coursework from multiple disciplines and institutions
- Internship/s and CPL

Support

- Individualized guided pathways
- Embedded advising
- Case management approach


- Admit year range 1998-2024




NASH Catalyst Award
