CSUBIOTECH is pleased to announce the Fall 2023 round of travel grant awards. CSUBIOTECH is making 20 awards totaling \$29,456 to CSU faculty and students at 11 CSU campuses.

Student Travel Grant Awards

The opportunity to present research results, participate in workshops or collect research data is crucial to biotechnology students' professional development. The CSUBIOTECH Student Travel Grant Program supports CSU student travel to biotechnology-related professional meetings and workshops or to collect biotechnology-related data at shared instrumentation facilities or research sites.
